

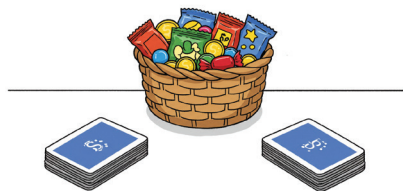
LUCKY DOG CARD GAME



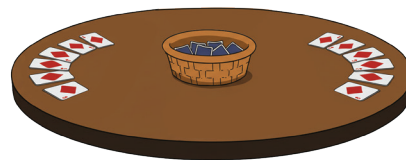
Benefits: Increase concentration, socialization, increase recognition, eye hand coordination

Most people are familiar with playing cards and feel comfortable handling them. For folks with memory challenges, this is a fun game that continues the excitement of playing cards.

How many players: 2-8 (8 players deal 5 cards)



Equipment: Two decks of cards, a bowl or basket placed in the center of the table. Small prizes (candy, mini packaged snacks, quarters)



Set up: Deal 6 cards facing up on the table for each player. Place a basket or bowl on the center of the table for the discarded cards.

The object of the game is to be the **first person to get rid of all their cards.**

How to Play: The Dealer pulls a card from the 2nd deck and calls out what it is and shows the card to the players. The player with that card puts the card in the basket. The Dealer will continue to call and show the cards until one player has no more cards. **They are the winner. The Lucky Dog!**
